2024 Membership Information, Schedule, and Application

CMGA MEMBERSHIP INORMATION:

Joining the Crossings Men's Golf Association (CMGA) provides its members with a standing starting time every Sunday morning at 8:00 am Shotgun starts. (9:00 am during winter months), five prepaid entries into major tournaments, the ability to play in five additional CMGA tournaments (for a registration fee of \$20 ea.) Any signups for the CMGA after July 1st will not be eligible for the prize pool in any remaining majors.

As a CMGA member your green fees will be reduced by 20% of the going rack rate for CMGA events and Sunday play only!

All memberships need to be processed and paid by March 1,2024 through the CMGA committee.

The CMGA shall be managed by a committee of members as designated. The committee includes Duane Drew, Joe Butkus and Dave Rothrock.

The committee shall manage the CMGA tournaments and the weekly Sunday events. The professional staff of The Crossings will be there to assist the committee and answer questions concerning rules and rulings.

SUNDAY MORNING PLAY: A member must sign up for all Sunday events (tournament and non-tournament events) through the Crossings Clubhouse staff **no later than Thursday, 5:00 pm** to be included in the association standing tee play for the following Sunday. Members who are not signed up through the clubhouse by the stated time **will not** be included in that Sunday's event but may play as an add on at the end of the pairings providing there is room!

Sunday play shall be year-round @ 8:00 am with shotgun starts (Groupings set at 7:30am) - Winter season play will start at 9:00 am (Groupings set at 8:30)

SUNDAY CUP SERIES: The Sunday Cup Series is a separate season long (March through November) FedEx Cup style series run by Duane Drew. Entry fee for the season shall be \$30.00 payable to Duane by March 17th. Points shall be awarded based on players results in the monthly tournaments. (9 Total). See sheet attached.

HANDICAP SERVICE: All players need to have a handicap to be part of the CMGA. These services are included in CMGA fees or the Crossing annual membership plan.

TOURNAMENTS AND PRIZES: Each month (March – November) the CMGA hosts an official event. At these events Green Fees and Cart fees if required. (Crossings Members, only cart fee required) There are five **MAJOR** tournaments throughout the year that are included in the CMGA membership dues (ABCD Team Points, Late Spring Gross/Net, Member/Member, CMGA Championship and Presidents Cup). Prizes, Food and/or Beverages are provided by the Association membership dues.

All CTPs will be paid out as a Crossing gift card.

There are also five non-major CMGA tournaments (Bubba shamble - Easy day / Hard day, Red - White & Blue, Match Play event and the Superintendent's revenge) shall have an entry fee of \$20.00 (plus regular fees for carts and greens fees (if required). The entire entry fee goes to the prize fund, depending on turn out, the more people play the higher the pay outs.

Sign up for all events through the professional staff at The Crossings clubhouse **no later than 5:00pm** the Thursday prior to the event. Check in shall be in the dining area no later than 7:30 am to get pairings and pay game fees.

Late check ins shall not be in the game!

The regular Sunday games shall be \$15.00 for the game and skins.
